Position Title: Classroom Presenter/Environmental Educator- King and Snohomish Counties

Designation: Part-time (flexible 1-3 days per week) during school year

Salary: \$20.00 - \$25.00 an hour commensurate with experience.

DESCRIPTION

Triangle Associates Inc., a small environmental consulting firm, is looking for a dependable and enthusiastic educator to present in-person conservation themed classroom programs for grades 1-12. Presenters will teach multiple classes per day within a school, providing a 45-60 minute workshop for each classroom, throughout King and Snohomish Counties. **We are seeking candidates looking for a position with a flexible schedule. This work can range from 1-3 days per week, approximately 3-8 hours per day, throughout the school year.** The ideal candidate will have experience working with diverse youth audiences and demonstrate an understanding of environmental justice concepts, as well as diversity, equity, and inclusion principles.

Note: We are hiring for the 2022-2023 school year and this position will start in Fall 2022. This work will take place in-person at different schools throughout the King and Snohomish County area, Covid safety requirements permitting.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Minimum two years of experience teaching students ages 6-18 in a formal or non-formal setting (classroom setting preferred, and experience with youth in grades 6-12 preferred).
- Excellent classroom management skills and ability to work under pressure in a dynamic school setting.
- Able to adapt teaching style for various ages and learning styles, including voice projection, improvisational skills, and creative energy to teach lessons and present information in an engaging and hands-on manner.
- Demonstrate an understanding of cultural competency and show sensitivity and thoughtfulness when working with diverse populations.
- Basic background knowledge of and interest in learning more about environmental issues such as waste reduction, water conservation and pollution prevention, renewable energy, climate change (helpful but not required).
- Excellent organizational and self-managing skills.
- Clear, written and verbal communication skills with attention to detail.

REQUIREMENTS

- A reliable car, valid Washington State driver's license, clean driving record, and auto insurance covering bodily injury and property damage. (This position requires driving to schools and transporting classroom materials.)
- Presenter must be available to work during school hours with possible early travel start times for presentations at secondary schools (between 6 AM and 5 PM).
- Ability to check and respond to email daily.

- Ability to carry 30 lbs. of workshop materials.
- Ability to pass a background check.
- Ability to show proof of vaccination against Covid-19.
